**Accademia dell'Arte in partnership with MUW offer an early decision policy for entry into the MFA in Physical Theatre fall 2011.**

Accademia dell'Arte is accepting applications for entry into the MFA in Physical Theatre for fall 2011. Candidates who are eligible may apply for a fee reduction for the first year of study amounting to €1000 (EUR) if they satisfy the conditions of the early decision policy.

**The early decision policy is open to candidates who accept and fulfill the following conditions:**

1. Must apply with relevant documents, reference letters and official transcripts by December 1, 2010
2. Must have an undergraduate degree and GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Candidates must attend a scheduled audition and interview (dates listed below) or request a one-on-one audition and interview (subject to availability of faculty)
4. DVD auditions will not be accepted for early decision candidates
5. Candidates must be prepared for a callback or further interview before a decision as to their eligibility for the program may be reached
6. The decision of the heads of department at Accademia dell'Arte and MUW is final
7. Candidates who are offered a place in the MFA in Physical Theatre for entry in fall 2011 must accept the offer within the time frame stipulated in the offer and under no circumstances later than January 1, 2011
8. In order to secure their place in the program, candidates who accept the offer must submit a deposit to Accademia dell'Arte (this deposit will be refunded only under strict conditions)
9. Candidates who wish to withdraw from their commitment to the MFA in Physical Theatre and apply for other programs may only do so with the express permission of Accademia dell'Arte
10. The early decision policy is applicable only to candidates who are residents of the United States

Candidates who are eligible for the early decision policy will be granted a fee reduction of €1000 (EUR) that will be spread out over the three semesters of the first year of study only. Students who receive this fee reduction are entitled to apply for scholarship and assistantships.
